

How do I buy Bitcoin in Sweden?

A simple step-by-step guide if you want to buy a small amount of bitcoin in Sweden and send it as a voluntary donation to Sverigefakta.

You normally need BankID (Sweden's national e-identification), a payment method and a bitcoin wallet. The options offered may change at each service.

How it works - four steps

1 Choose a service

Pick a service where you can buy bitcoin with Swedish kronor (SEK). Below we show two established Swedish providers: Safello and BTCX.

2 Verify your identity

Follow the service's instructions and verify yourself with BankID, the electronic ID used by almost every Swedish bank. Crypto services are normally required to identify their customers.

Identification happens at the service you choose, never at Sverigefakta.

3 Buy bitcoin

Enter the amount you want to buy, choose an available payment method — often a card, bank transfer or Swish, the Swedish instant payment app — and check the rate, fee and total cost before confirming.

You decide the amount. Never buy more than you can afford to lose.

4 Send your support

Open your bitcoin wallet, choose "Send", scan Sverigefakta's QR code or paste the address, and check the address carefully before approving.

Two ways to buy

Buy via Safello

Safello is a Swedish exchange offering purchases with BankID and Swedish payment methods. Bitcoin can be held in Safello Wallet and then sent to Sverigefakta's address.

BankID → Buy bitcoin → Open the wallet → Send to the QR code

Buy via BTCX

BTCX is a Swedish provider offering purchases with BankID and several payment options. The service is built around delivering purchased bitcoin to your own wallet.

Prepare your own wallet → BankID → Buy bitcoin → Send the donation from your wallet

Features, payment methods, prices and fees can change. Always check the current information at each service before completing a purchase.

Check this before you send

- Check the first and last characters of the address.
- Only use the address shown on Sverigefakta's official domain.
- Only send BTC over the Bitcoin network.
- Never share passwords, seed phrases or private keys.
- Sverigefakta will never call anyone and instruct them to buy bitcoin.
- Check the service fee and the network fee before confirming.
- For larger amounts, consider a small test transaction first.

Sverigefakta never does this

- Asks for your seed phrase or private key.
- Receives BankID signatures.
- Stores your wallet address.
- Handles the purchase or acts as an intermediary towards Safello or BTCX.

Risk and tax

Bitcoin can rise or fall sharply in value. This page is a practical guide for voluntary donations and is not investment advice.

Frequently asked questions

How do you buy bitcoin in Sweden?

You choose a service selling bitcoin in Swedish kronor, verify your identity with BankID, enter an amount and pay with an available payment method. You can then send the bitcoin to your own wallet or to a recipient address.

Can I buy bitcoin with Swish?

Some Swedish services offer Swish, Sweden's instant payment app, as a payment method. Available methods vary over time — check what the service offers in its purchase flow.

Do I need a bitcoin wallet?

To control your own bitcoin you need a wallet. Some services offer a built-in wallet, others deliver the purchase straight to an address you provide.

What is the difference between Safello and BTCX?

Safello offers purchase and a built-in wallet in one service. BTCX focuses on delivering purchased bitcoin to your own wallet. Check current features and fees at each service.

How do I send bitcoin to Sverigefakta?

Open your wallet, choose “Send”, scan the QR code on this page or paste the address, enter the amount and confirm after checking the address.

How do I verify that the address is correct?

Compare the first and last characters with what is shown on Sverigefakta's official domain, and prefer the copy button or the QR code over typing the address manually.

Can a bitcoin transaction be reversed?

No. A confirmed bitcoin transaction normally cannot be recalled, so check the address and amount before approving.

What fees may apply?

The service may charge a fee or add a spread to the exchange rate, and the network charges a transaction fee when you send. Fees vary — check the total cost in the purchase flow.

Does Sverigefakta receive compensation from Safello or BTCX?

No. The links are plain external links without affiliate parameters, and Sverigefakta has no commercial agreements with the services.

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
